Office.

There are several ways to get to Leiria. You can choose between Oporto and Lisbon Airport, but the Lisbon Airport is closer to Leiria. You can take the Underground at Lisbon airport take the read line until "S. Sebastião" and then change to blue line and go until "Jardim Zoológico". You'll find the Coach station where you can pick a bus until Leiria every 1.00hour/1.30 hours. See:
