The Polytechnic Institute of Leiria will accept applications to the international edition of the Master in **Product Design**, under the following conditions:

1. Number of Applications

General contingent: 20 places

Portuguese and European Union Nationals as well as those legally residing in Portugal, uninterruptedly, for more than 2 years¹ in 31/08/2018, as well as the children who legally reside with them.

International student contingent: 5 places

For non EU nationals not residing in Portugal uninterruptedly for more than 2 years in 31/08/2018.

Remaining places in any contingent may eventually be reverted to the other by the end of the application process.

2. Application:

Application is submitted at <http://www.candidaturas.ipleiria.pt/> and considered valid after uploading the supporting documentation and paying the application fee.

2.1. Supporting documents:

- A signed and detailed *Curriculum vitae*;
- Copy of ID document and VAT number;
- Copy of detailed academic certificate with date of graduation, degree awarded and final classification²;
- Proof of legal address of residence. (only for non EU-Nationals legally residing in Portugal uninterruptedly for more than two years in 31/08/2017, and children who legally reside with them);
- Proof of payment of the application fee.
- Portfolio* (≤100 Mb)

3. Conditions of applications and entry

You can apply if you the following:

- Holders of a undergraduation degree or legal equivalent in the areas of industrial design, equipment design, product design, communication design, graphic design, multimedia design, environments design, interior design, fine arts, new media, architecture.
- Holders of a foreign academic degree, conferred following a 1st cycle course organized according to the principles

of the Bologna Process by an adherent State, in the areas of industrial design, equipment design, product design, communication design, graphic design, multimedia design, environments design, interior design, fine arts, new media, architecture.

- Holders of a foreign academic degree that is recognized by the technical-scientific council of ESAD.CR as fulfilling the objectives of an undergraduation degree in scientific areas mention in a);
- Holders of an academic, scientific or professional curriculum, which is recognized by the technical-scientific council of ESAD.CR as attesting to the candidate's capacity to carry out this cycle of studies;
- Students who are in the conclusion phase of an undergraduation degree in scientific areas whose detention is required to join the master and who declare this fact in the application.

4. Selection Criteria

The candidate's selection will be made according to the following criteria:
