Created in 1990, the School of Arts and Design of Caldas da Rainha (ESAD.CR) is dedicated to teaching arts and design, being one of the 5 schools of the Polytechnic of Leiria, a public institution of higher education that is proud to provide quality education and to have a training offer that encompasses practically all areas of knowledge.

Located in Caldas da Rainha, a city with a vast artistic and cultural heritage, the School assumes a posture of contemporaneity in the various fields of creativity such as fine arts, performing arts, product design, communication, audio visual production, and emerging trends in the area of new media.

The quality of the creations and productions developed in the various courses as well as the participation of the students and teachers in national competitions and international organizations have been acknowledged with numerous prizes. The School has become a benchmark in the panorama of national artistic education, having come to progressively conquer a place alongside the best European institutions.

ESAD.CR is frequented by about 1.600 students of Short Cycles, Undergraduate Programmes and Master's degrees.

These courses aim to transmit to students practical and conceptual skills for the production of original works and creations, allowing for autonomous and sustainable development of their creative processes, to consolidate an authorial, experimental and systematic practice. Critical and professional awareness of the problems of artistic and projectual production in its social and political impacts is stimulated, in a permanent focus on emerging sectors of contemporary culture.

Our teaching methods are focused on the development of the student towards an autonomous project, in a practice based on a set of cross-cutting principles, monitored by Professors.

We incorporate a high ethical sense of social responsibility and capabilities to carry out project activities integrated into different production scenarios, optimizing effectiveness and sustainability of the developed products.

The living heritage linked to craftsmanship and the living presence of raw materials such as vegetable fibers for basketry or the famous cork, as well as a strong ceramic production in the region, make this goal easier to attain.

All courses are heavily shaped by the centrality attributed to laboratorial and experimental practice based on the availability of workshops and studio workspaces.

Students are invited to develop their projects in a creative and technical way, and regularly join in on professional partnerships - both in industry and in artisanal manufacturing.

For the final semester, students can choose between an internship (national or international) or carrying out a course final project.

A medium-sized school in a medium-sized city creates an alternative and culturally effervescent scenery on an appropriate scale to new urban sustainable mobility paradigms.

SHORT CYCLES //
SCHOOL OF ARTS AND DESIGN
CALDAS DA RAINHA

Short cycles are cycles of higher education study that last for four academic semesters to which correspond 120 ECTS. Short cycles include the components of general and scientific training, technical and in a work context. The training component in a work context (internship) has the duration of one academic semester. The completion of the Short Cycle allows oneself to obtain a higher technical diploma equivalent to level 5 of the National Qualifications Framework.

AUDIOVISUAL AND MULTIMEDIA

The Short Cycle in Audiovisual and Multimedia aims to train professionals capable of conceiving, planning and developing the technical and artistic operation of in multiple communication contexts; as well as carrying out the installation/maintenance of multimedia audiovisual systems and the design of multimedia audiovisual objects of various kinds.

DIGITAL MEDIA DESIGN

The Short Cycle in Digital Media Design aims to train capable professionals to design, conceive and implement solutions for digital media design, using proper technical tools adapted to design methodology, contributing in teams and diversified professional contexts the development and execution of services and digital multimedia products. This course has one class operating in Torres Vedras.

ILLUSTRATION AND GRAPHIC PRODUCTION

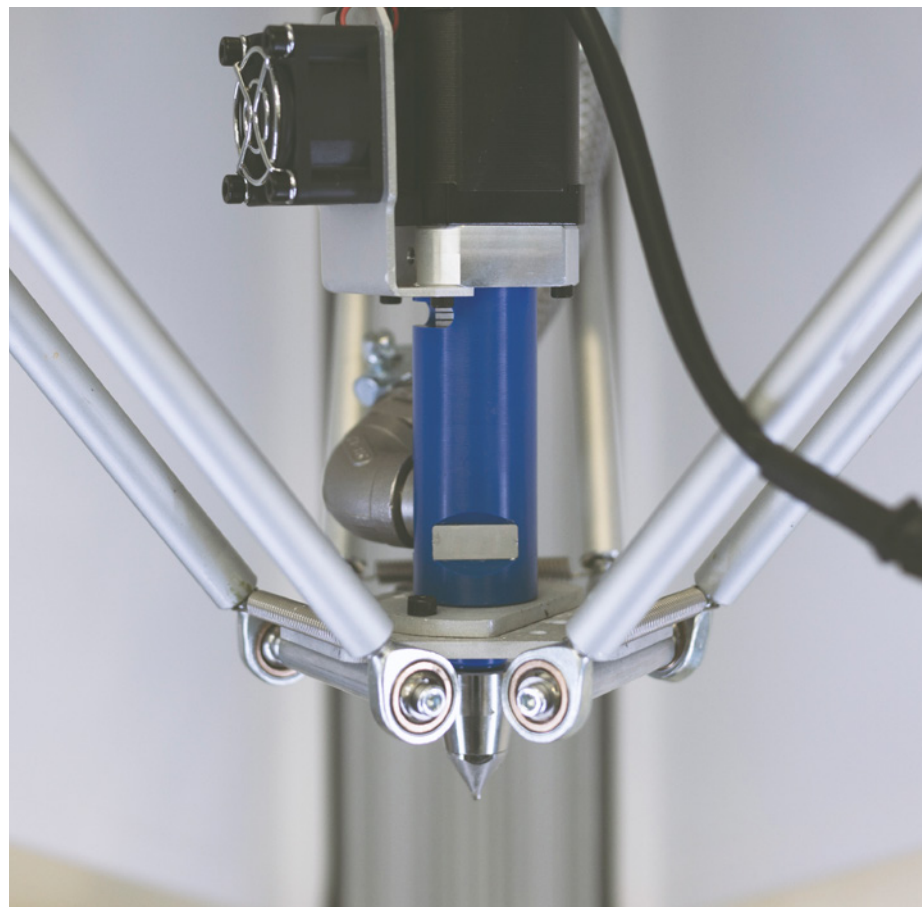
The Short Cycle in Illustration and Graphic Production aims to train professionals capable of designing, planning and executing illustration and graphic communication objects, autonomously and precisely, integrating digital and analogue technologies, considering the quantity and quality of reproducibility in production.

DIGITAL PROTOTYPING AND 3D DRAWING

The Short Cycle in Digital Prototyping and 3D Drawing aims to train professionals to be able to design, plan and execute projects of product development, using digital 3D design tools, of visualization and optimization, to produce virtual or physical objects, through traditional technologies or additive manufacturing.

INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION AND PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT - CERAMICS AND GLASS

The Short Cycle in Industrial Production and Product Development – Ceramics and Glass aims to train professionals capable of performing in the various stages of the ceramic and glass processes, from the selection of raw materials to the quality control of final products, including product development.

FINE ARTS

The course is characterized by the importance attributed to its laboratory practice both in workshops and studios. The teaching methodology focuses on the individual development of the project, accompanied by the Professor, equipping students with an ability towards conceptual problematization and experimentation.

INTERIOR AND SPATIAL DESIGN

This course provides solid knowledge in areas ranging from interior design, design exhibitions, scenography or public space where students are invited to develop their projects in a creative and technical way, and regularly associating with professional partnerships.

PRODUCT DESIGN - CERAMICS AND GLASS

This course is absolutely unique in Portugal. Focused on the design and development of products, for industry and craft manufacturing, this Undergraduate Programme offers unique conditions in the area of Ceramics & Glass for the acquisition of conceptual, projectual and practical skills.

GRAPHIC AND MULTIMEDIA DESIGN

In this course, students acquire theoretical and practical skills for the development of visual communication objects, on paper, on screen or hybrid platforms, with a high sense of authorship while applying the transdisciplinary knowledge that life demands.

INDUSTRIAL DESIGN

The course provides students with skills that allow them to design with a high ethical sense and social responsibility, in addition to developing capacities to carry out project activities, integrated into different production scenarios, optimizing the effectiveness and sustainability of the products developed.

PROGRAMMING AND CULTURAL PRODUCTION

This Undergraduate Programme is one of the only higher education courses in Portugal simultaneously dedicated to the areas of programming, curatorship, management and artistic production. To a solid theoretical basis in the field of artistic studies, this Undergraduate Programme brings together a practical aspect in which skills are exercised in all stages of the construction of artistic projects. Again, the School's implementation allows students to create a very close proximity to different civil society institutions.

SOUND AND IMAGE

The Undergraduate Programme in Sound and Image offers theoretical, technical and artistic training in the various areas of audiovisual, simultaneously developing critical and creative skills. Throughout their curriculum path, students choose their own route, being able to choose between broad training in various media or restricting their training to more specific, specialized interests, such as studies related to sound, cinema and video, photography or animation.

THEATRE

This Undergraduate Programme is focused on training actors and is suitable for students who also wish to become professionals in other areas of theatre practice, such as dramaturgy, production and performance. Throughout the course, students are actively involved in the preparation of public performances.

ARTS OF SOUND AND IMAGE

The course aims to provide students with specific skills for innovation in the stages of project development in Arts of Sound and Image, promote autonomy for technological experimentation in order to make fit decisions concerning the needs of each project, and encourage the development of a work methodology which combines critical capacity and material expression in the heterogeneous panorama of arts and contemporary audiovisual technologies.

FINE ARTS

Explore and deepen creative, practical and conceptual skills, in the production of original works and creations, within the broad spectrum of Contemporary Artistic Practices. It is intended that students develop, through their practical work, an operational and critical awareness of cultural, social and political impacts of contemporary artistic production. The student will be guided towards the individual deepening of skills that allow oneself to consolidate an authorial, experimental and systematic artistic practice.

PRODUCT DESIGN

This master's degree aims to train professionals to be capable of carrying out the activity of product designers in different production scenarios, while looking for optimizing the effectiveness and sustainability of the developed products. It is oriented towards the structuring of individual project paths, focused on students, in their interests and motivations. It intends to consolidate critical sense and the structuring of an autonomous thinking and creative territory, as well as a responsible and intervening professional practice when it comes to production processes in our globalized world.

GRAPHIC DESIGN

The Master in Graphic Design aims to provide practical and conceptual skills of a high professional level in specific areas of the graphic and communication design for multiple platforms, supports and media that characterize the visual contemporary culture. Besides traditional supports of communication design, emerging areas in editorial design, packaging, typography, information design, illustration, direction art, branding and multimedia production will be explored.

DESIGN FOR HEALTH AND WELL BEING

It is a pioneering master's degree in the field of products' design, innovating solutions, platforms, apps and services in the area of health and well-being, aiming to promote quality of life. This master's degree follows a tradition of interdisciplinary experimentation, ESAD.CR's trademark, by integrating in one training programmatic contents that cross the domain of design, with knowledge from the areas of sciences of life and engineering.

CULTURAL MANAGEMENT

This master's degree aims to provide specialized training in Cultural Management, through learning and developing direct and qualified investigation and observation methodologies of institutional practices in this area of professional activity. Moreover, it provides the acquisition and the exercitation of specific skills that a cultural manager must have, both in the formulation of plans and projects as well as in the daily activity of managing diverse equipment.

THEATRE WORKSHOP

A multidisciplinary space, consisting of two Backboxes, a body room, an amphitheatre auditorium and warehouses. The Workshop has a variety of lighting and sound design equipment, rigging, scene machinery, enabling and supporting the theatrical and/or performative practice developed by the Theatre Undergraduate Programme.

PRINTMAKING AND SILKSCREEN WORKSHOP

The silkscreen workshop has: five printing tables, a sensing machine and a washing tank with a washing compressor. The printmaking workshop has five presses available: woodcut press for wood arrays, or linoleum matrix printmaking, lithographic press for stone matrices, printmaking press for horizontal matrices on metal, printmaking press for any vertical matrix and a binding press for the binding of artist's books.

PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOP

The Photography Workshop is a space of creativity, imagination and responsibility, where all the students of ESAD.CR can make their projects happen using different studio spaces and photography equipment. Whether in the specific context of classes or as autonomous work, students can use the photography studio and all its lighting and stage equipment, as well as the analogic and digital photography laboratories, to develop and edit their images. At the digital laboratory, an array of computers with editing and image manipulation software is available. At the analogic laboratory, students can develop their films and images on photographic paper.

CERAMICS, PLASTER AND GLASS WORKSHOP

This workshop provides a space for the development of ceramics, plaster and glass projects. This space is organised by work areas, namely a small laboratory, an area for mould filling, areas with working tables, a pottery and plaster section, a space to work with cold glass, a section dedicated to the parts to be baked, and one section for the finished parts. The space has a number of aiding equipment, from modelling tools, tools for glass, laminator, spinneret, drying oven, electric potter's wheel, plaster lathes, glazing booth, electric ovens, and stirrers, among others.

AUDIOVISUALS WORKSHOP

The workshop works extended hours and offers a wide selection of specific equipment to the Sound and Image Undergraduate Programme and the other courses, as well as technical-scientific and artistic support. It also offers several workstations with audiovisual production software (Premiere, Protools, etc). The workshop also manages the Video Studio and the Sound Studio, as well as the technical facilities of Auditorium 1.

COMMON LABORATORY FOR EXPERIMENTATION AND DIALOGUE

Aims to provide a space for use and experimentation for its users during extended hours. The student will be able to develop their work autonomously and use the machines and materials available without needing the Professor's authorization.

DIGITAL WORKSHOP

The Digital Workshop is the place for everything related with printing, scanning and layout of graphic works made by students and staff for academic purposes, as well as the carrying out of work services benefiting the Polytechnic of Leiria or the community. Students' academic works made in the context of course assignments, under a teacher's guidance, and subject to the supervision of one of the workshop's technicians. The specialized works that provide support to the school, to the Polytechnic of Leiria or to the community, are always carried out under the specific instructions of the School's administration or the responsible teacher.

METAL WORKSHOP

The Metal Workshop is currently one of the best-equipped School workshops in the country. Throughout the years, its facilities have enabled hundreds of successful projects to be carried out in the areas of fine arts, in particular, sculpture and installation works, and in the different courses related to the design area, in the design of prototypes and conception of individual and group projects. The Metal Workshop was built for the following purposes: to provide practical knowledge about the various techniques associated with its equipment; give detailed information on the existing equipment and help improve the understanding of the workshop logistics to everyone in the academic community from different courses that use this space to carry out works of a curricular and extracurricular nature.

WOOD WORKSHOP

The wood workshop supports the development and carrying out of students' projects of the different courses of ESAD.CR. It also provides technical support to the Polytechnic of Leiria, and to projects with different partners. The workshop provides permanent monitoring of a technician supporting the users in search of constructive solutions tailored to each project. The technical capacity of the workshop enables the carrying out of a wide variety of works such as: formal and volumetric studies of objects, functional studies such as tests of gear mechanisms, articulation and connections between parts, prototypes, models and final parts such as structures or furniture.

DIGITAL PROTOTYPING LABORATORY

The Digital Prototyping Laboratory, besides directly supporting some courses, provides 3D printing services to the academic community, companies and institutions that have a protocol with Polytechnic of Leiria and also support research projects. It is equipped with a Z450 3D printer from 3DSystems which enables the development of prototypes for a formal evaluation that works with plaster-based materials with a useful area of 250x200x200 (mm). The lab is not open to the public. In order for the services to be provided, a 3D (STL) file of the project to be printed must be sent to the email: esad.cad@gmail.com. The student receives a quotation with the expenses of the consumables. Once the quotation is approved, the printed piece may be collected from the Accounting office, on a scheduled date.

STUDENT OMBUDSMAN

Caldas da Rainha is a Portuguese city in the district of Leiria, with 30.426 inhabitants in its urban perimeter and is part of the Oeste Intermunicipal Community of the centre region.

Since 2019, Caldas da Rainha has been a UNESCO Creative City in the field of Crafts and Folk Art. Founded in the 15th century, the city of 51.600 inhabitants is known for its thermal waters and its 500-year-old ceramic tradition.

A very strong creative community, driven by the School of Arts and Design of the Polytechnic of Leiria and the many cultural associations of civil society, finds in the city several museums dedicated to heritage (sculpture, painting and ceramics), numerous institutions dedicated to cultural and creative development and the arts in general, but also a business network that opens up creative perspectives through design.

In the city, there is a rich relationship between small workshops and industry, which makes it possible to go beyond the traditional boundaries of the relationship between craftsmen and industry.
