Corrigendum to Public Notice No. 392/2021

Summary: Amends to Public Notice No. 1182/2020, published in the *Diário da República*, 2nd series, No. 218, of November 9th, 2020, regarding the documentary contest to recruit two adjunct professors, for the disciplinary area of Nursing, Medical-Surgical specialty, from the School of Health Sciences of the Polytechnic of Leiria.

Have being published with an error a material manifested in the expression of the will detectable by the mere reading of the minutes of the jury of 6/24/2020 and of the corresponding Public Notice no. 1182/2020, of November 9th, regarding the definition of the final classification formula, harmful to the same extent to all candidates for the competition, due to the fact that there is a double application of the percentages attributed to the candidates' Technical-Scientific and Professional Performance (DTCP), Pedagogical Capacity of the candidates (CP) and Other Relevant Activities for the mission of the higher education institution developed by the candidates (AR), concretely, a first time in the partial assessment of these dimensions and, in a second moment, in the final classification formula, it is rectified, under article 174th of the Code of Administrative Procedure, Notice no. 1182/2020, published in the *Diário da República*, 2nd series, no. 218, of November 9th, 2020, regarding the documentary competition for the recruitment of two adjunct professors, in the form of an open-ended public service employment contract, for the disciplinary area of Nursing, Medical-Surgical specialty, for the School of Health Sciences of the Polytechnic of Leiria.

Thus, in point 7.5, where it reads:

" The final classification (CF), on a scale from 0 to 100 points, will be obtained by the following formula: CF = (0.45DTCP + 0.45CP + 0.10AR), considering as 'not approved' the candidates who obtain final classification below 50 points and 'approved in absolute merit' candidates who obtain a final classification equal to or greater than 50 points. All results will be rounded up and presented to one decimal place.";

It should read:

"7.5 - The final classification (CF), on a scale from 0 to 100 points, will be obtained by the following formula: CF = (DTCP + CP + AR), considering as "not approved" candidates who obtain a final classification below 50 points and 'approved in absolute merit' candidates who obtain a final classification equal to or greater than 50 points. All results will be rounded up and presented to one decimal place.".
