

Rectification Statement no.16/2022

Due to inaccuracy in the publication in the *Diário da República*, 2nd series, no. 241, of December 15, 2021, the Public Notice no. 1431/2021 (documentary competition for the recruitment of a Senior Lecturer, in the subject area of Languages and Literatures – Chinese/Portuguese, at the School of Education and Social Sciences of the Polytechnic of Leiria), it is hereby rectified as follows:

1. In no. 6.3 of the Public Notice, the following paragraph g) is added with the following content:

«g) Documents proving that the candidate is bilingual in the languages referred to in no. 1 of this public notice; »

2. In no. 7 of the Public Notice, no. 7.10 is added with the following content:

«7.10 — It is furthermore considered not approved in absolute merit the candidates who are not bilingual in the languages referred to in no. 1 of this public notice; »

3. In no. 8, where it reads:

Public Hearing: The Jury may determine the holding of public hearings, which will be attended in accordance to Article 28(4) of Official Order No.10990/2010. If these public hearings are required, they shall take place between the 20th and 70th days following the deadline for submission of applications and all candidates shall be informed at least five days in advance of the date and place of the public hearings.

It should read:

Public Hearing: The Jury may determine the holding of public hearings, namely for the purposes of the referred in no. 6.3 (g), which will be attended in accordance to Article 28(4) of Order No.10990/2010. If these public hearings are required, they shall take place between the 20th and 70th days following the deadline for submission of applications and all candidates shall be informed at least five days in advance of the date and place of the public hearings.

4. In view of the above, the period for the submission of applications will be extended, expiring within 30 working days from the publication of this rectification statement in the *Diário da República*.
